SCIP DATABASE

Get ready to submit your SCIP
notification with Substantio

WHAT IS SCIP?

SCIP (**S**ubstances of **C**oncern **I**n **P**roducts) is the European database to collect all information on **substances of very high concern in articles or complex objects**. It aims to improve the knowledge of these hazardous substances throughout their life cycle, including the waste phase.

WHO IS AFFECTED?

Companies that operate as

- **DISTRIBUTORS,**
- **PRODUCERS** or
- **ASSEMBLERS**

in the role of „**SUPPLIER**“ of a product and do not supply it directly and exclusively to the end consumer.

WHICH ITEMS ARE AFFECTED?

All articles produced, imported, compounded or distributed by you as a supplier that **contain substances on the ECHA SVHC candidate list above the permitted threshold value:**

SVHC > **0.1%** (w/w)
substance mass percent

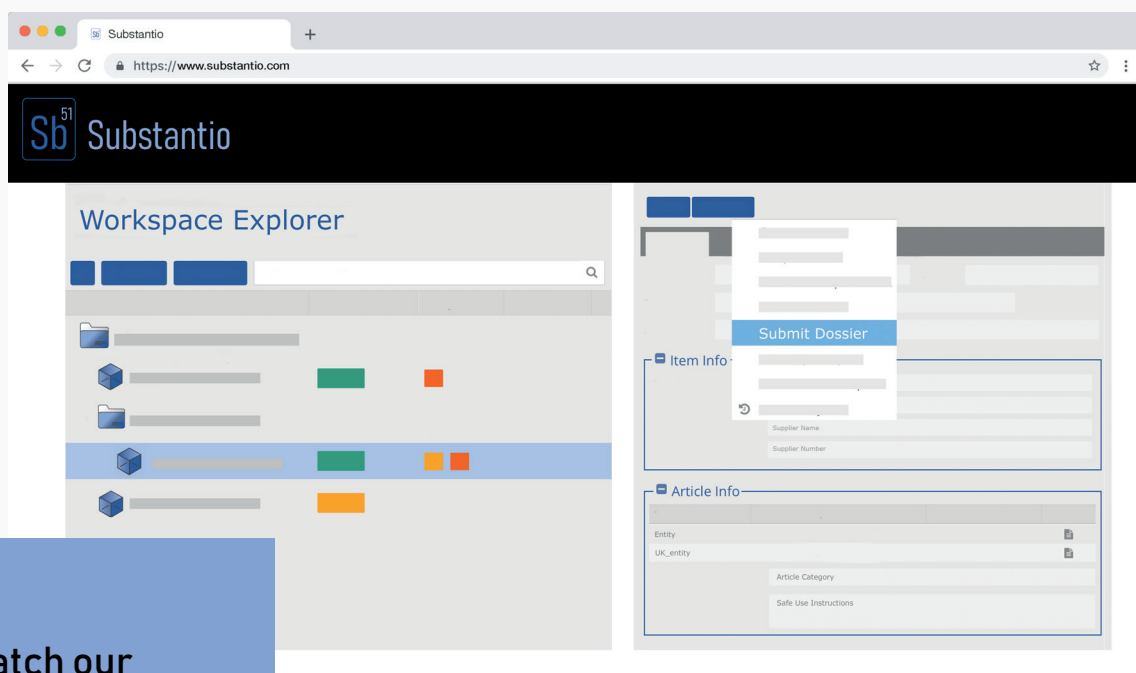
This notification requirement has been in place since
05th January 2021

HOW TO SUBMIT THE DATA WITH SUBSTANTIO?

After you have registered on the official ECHA website and thus received your **Legal Entity ID**, you can request your personal **S2S-Key**. You will deposit this data within your Substantio account.

The submission of your declaration information to the SCIP database can now be done with a few clicks within the **workspace in Substantio**.

To do this, **select the part and click: „Submit Dossier“ in the drop-down menu**. Select one or more legal entities and confirm the submission with the Submit Dossiers button.
