Get ready to submit your SCIP notification with Substantio

WHATIS SCIP?

SCIP (Substances of Concern In Products) is the European database to collect all information on **substances of very high concern in articles or complex objects**. It aims to improve the knowledge of these hazardous substances throughout their life cycle, including the waste phase.

WHO IS AFFECTED?

Companies that operate as

- DISTRIBUTORS,
- PRODUCERS or
- ASSEMBLERS

in the role of "**SUPPLIER**" of a product and <u>do not</u> supply it directly and exclusively to the end consumer.

WHICH ITEMS ARE AFFECTED?

All articles produced, imported, compounded or distributed by you as a supplier that contain substances on the ECHA SVHC candidate list above the permitted threshold value:

SVHC > **0.1%** (w/w) substance mass percent

This notification requirement has been in place since **05th January 2021**




HOW TO SUBMIT THE DATA WITH SUBSTANTIO?

After you have registered on the official ECHA website and thus received your **Legal Entity ID**, you can request your personal **S2S-Key**. You will deposit this data within your Substantio account.

The submission of your declaration information to the SCIP database can now be done with a few clicks within the **workspace in Substantio**.

To do this, select the part and click: "Submit Dossier" in the dropdown menu. Select one or more legal entities and confirm the submission with the Submit Dossiers button.



If desired, a link will take you directly to the **ECHA website** to have an **overview of all your SCIP submissions**.
